If you plan to attend any of our regularly scheduled Sunday Masses with a Congregation, please note the following directives that must be met in order for attendance in our absolutely beautiful church:

- ✠ Masks are only required when entering or leaving church, you may remove the masks when seated.
- ✠ Families and those who travel to church together may sit together. All others are asked to please sit at least six feet apart from one another.
- ✠ If the weather permits, families are encouraged to bring chairs and sit on the south lawn of the church where they can hear Mass.

In addition to our regularly scheduled Sunday Masses, the generosity of the Grover family has made it possible for us to have Mass at 175 Woodcleft Avenue on the Nautical Mile: at 10:00 A.M. in English and in Spanish at 11:30 A.M. Parishioners are strongly encouraged to attend these outdoor Masses and to bring a chair.
