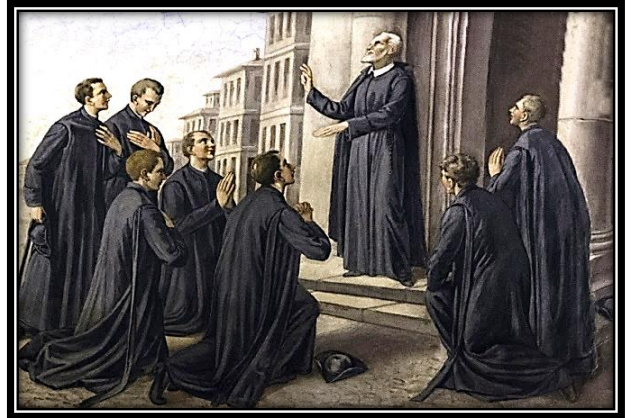

(25 Years of Age/25 August 2019)

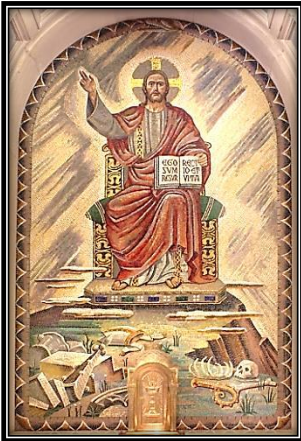
