

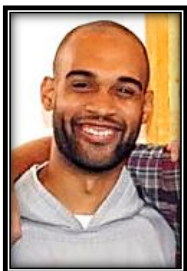


THEY LIKE YOU ... YOU LIKE THEM?

Sunday Mass-goers at the 5:00 P.M. Vigil Mass on Saturday, 20 May and the 9:30 A.M. and 11:30 A.M. Masses on Sunday, 21 May, were treated to one of the growing number of *reasons for our hope* (cf. I Saint Peter iii:15b) here at Our Holy Redeemer: Miss Meaghan Baldwin! Miss Baldwin, a parishioner of Our Holy Redeemer, “heard the voice of Jesus say” (as the song goes) “come follow Me” and so - like many of you – she followed Him:

- ✠ At Mass in our absolutely beautiful church where she also served as a Lector
- ✠ In Adoration in our Perpetual Adoration Chapel as a member of the Nocturnal Adoration Society
- ✠ On pilgrimage to Washington D.C. as a member of the Our Holy Redeemer Respect Life Family (OHRRLF)

- ✠ While praying the Rosary during Friday Family Rosary Night (Third Friday of the Month)
- ✠ As a member of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas
- ✠ During Parishioner Appreciation Day (Sunday after Labour Day)
- ✠ During Our Holy Redeemer’s Summer Family Picnic (call the Knights of Columbus)

Yes, Meaghan, like so many of you, heard the voice of Jesus say: “come follow Me” *many times and many ways*. Through them all, with help from the Priests, Deacons, Religious, and Lay-faithful in Freeport, she recognized that **the call to holiness and mission** was leading her to discover Jesus anew in Religious Life. And so Miss Baldwin sought and received admission into the **Parish Visitors of Mary Immaculate**, a Papal Congregation of women, faithful to the Church, founded in 1920 by Mother Mary Teresa Tallon to evangelize and catechize, and took up residence at the Motherhouse in Monroe, New York last September.
